**ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS**

Michael was absent and Bob Hearn chaired the meeting.

Bob Hearn said there may be a meeting to discuss the transportation issues of the community with the MTA. The hope is to have a revised plan.

Bob Hearn indicated there may also be a meeting with the Northern District Police and to have community involvement.

Chris McSherry said she met with Dave Montgomery, Traffic Division Chief of the Baltimore City Department of Transportation. Chris is waiting input for a plan related to traffic on Roland across from Gilman. Chris also mentioned that there was discussion about controlling speed on Roland and the cut through on side streets.

Bob Hearn updated the group concerning the Rotunda plans and said the developers are in the process of picking an architect. There is a pending transportation plan that is to be posted on the developer's web site, [www.GrandRotunda.com](http://www.GrandRotunda.com).

Mr. Hearn discussed the building of a shed at the Crown station on Falls Road. Michael is investigating the building and zoning permit issues.
