FREDERICK, Md. (AP) -- The trial of a man accused of hitting a pit bull puppy, fracturing its skull and blinding the animal, has been delayed.

Troy D. Goines of Frederick has been charged with felony and misdemeanor animal cruelty in the August incident. According to charging documents, Goines punched the dog in Discovery, a Walkersville subdivision. The dog's owner agreed to have it euthanized after its condition deteriorated.

An emergency kept a prosecution witness from appearing in Frederick County Circuit Court at a jury trial on Monday. The trial has been rescheduled for March 30.
