

Roland Park E-announcement
February 8, 2010

The recent heavy snow continues to be challenging and unfortunately, some streets remain unplowed. More snow is predicted late Tuesday. Some have asked who is responsible for plowing. The City is responsible for plowing public streets, all of them. If your street has not been plowed, your best course of action is to call 311 and if that is not successful, to write to or call your council person's office (email and phone numbers at <http://rolandpark.org/RPReps.html>).

The Roland Park Roads and Maintenance Organization takes responsibility for alleys (which are not owned by the City). Plowing occurred on Friday and Saturday but the operator's plow broke early morning and this delayed plowing on the alleys. To get to some alleys, the RM truck had to plow a portion of the street to reach the alley but this truck is not otherwise plowing city streets. If you live on an alley and that has not been plowed, write to RMVPMaintenance@rolandpark.org and to RMPresident@rolandpark.org and report your location.

The cost of RM plowing is paid by those who choose to pay 8x the minimum fee. Those who have not paid might remember that as the dues are going out now for RM. Please look out for each other out particularly elderly or those with health problems on your street who may be unable to get out. Please shovel your walks.
