Thank you for your email regarding the proposed Keswick Multi-Care Project at the Baltimore Country Club in the Roland Park Community. I understand the concerns you raised in your correspondence.

The Proposed Keswick Multi-Care Project requires a Planned Unit Development (a "PUD"). A PUD requires the approval of the City Council. I have spoken with Councilwoman Sharon Middleton and she has remained steadfast in her opposition to this project and has requested my support.

Please be clear that I have no intention of introducing the PUD. I also know that Councilwoman Middleton has no plans of introducing a PUD or any other legislation to change the current zoning to accommodate the project as proposed.
