Last evening, the Roland Park Civic League and its Land Use Committee met together to review the revised Keswick plan. All materials you provided were presented to our group and fully considered. As you indicated, no member from Keswick was able to attend our meeting.

The Civic League voted unanimously to approve the following resolution: "Be it resolved that the Roland Park Civic League, having reviewed the revised development proposal from Keswick Multi-Care for the land under purchase contract from Baltimore Country Club, and having found that no substantial change has been made, and none of the zoning issues addressed, does therefore on behalf of the Roland Park Community and for all of the reasons previously cited, continue its opposition to the Keswick Multi-Care Development Plan."
