1. Remember: "One Plus One" Starts on Tuesday.

Don't put your trash out tonight (Sunday)! Regardless of what you have been doing for the past several decades, no one will pick it up this Monday (July 13). There will be no trash pick up in the city anywhere on Monday and the new trash-and-recycling program — "One plus One" — kicks in on Tuesday. If you live east of Roland Avenue and/or south of Cold Spring Lane, your trash will be picked up on Tuesday morning, starting this week, and your recyclables on Thursday morning. If you live west of Roland Avenue and north of Cold Spring, Wednesday is trash day and Friday recycling day. Collection will start earlier than it used to, 6 a.m. instead of 7 a.m. All trash and/or recyclables must be out before 6 a.m. on collection day.
