1. Puppy Found on Kittery Lane in Roland Park.

Tonight [writes Colleen Aungst] I found a dog (maybe puppy, he looks to be about 5 or 6 mos. old) wandering in the rain on Kittery Lane, the alley directly off Merryman Court, off Keswick Rd. What I assume are his leash and collar (all intact, but the collar was unclashed) were a block down on the ground by a garbage can behind a garage on Kittery. There were no tags on the collar. The dog was of course scared and skittish at first, but I was able to get him into my car and take him to my house. Once I gained his trust with lots of biscuits, he's proven to be incredibly friendly. He and my dog (a Wheaton Terrier) have been playing together for the past 2 hours (I hope they tire soon...).

The dog is about 35-45 lbs, black with tan markings (maybe a lab/rottweiler mix?). He's pretty skinny, but not too bad. He was submissive at first (tail between his legs, butt down) but now he's VERY playful and friendly.

If anyone a) knows of someone in that area that may have lost a dog or b) would like to take this wonderful puppy in to their home, please contact me ASAP. I can't keep him because I have allergies, but if I didn't I'd probably beg my husband to keep him. By Wednesday if I can't find him a great home, I am going to take him to the Maryland SPCA, where I have no doubt he'll be adopted.
